



## What we do . . .

### Juried Shows

We have six juried shows annually that are open to all members for submittal and hang in our gallery in the Community Center for about two months each. Jurors within the region are invited by the Gallery Committee to select the show and award prizes. A seventh show is reserved for students of area schools and is always a crowd pleaser. Each show includes an opening reception.

### Arts Fest

Held in the spring each year, Arts Fest is a fun filled weekend with art booths at beautiful Blue Hole Regional Park. A juried selection of artists from our own League, along with regional and national artists, sell their art in an atmosphere

enhanced by non-stop, live music and great food. From its humble beginnings with just a dozen artists, Arts Fest has now grown to attract artists from all over the United States and Canada.

### Studio Tour

In the early fall, a selection of local artists open their studios to the public. Visitors thoroughly enjoy getting a peek at the artists' work environment, watching them work and a chance to purchase some special art.

### Show and Sale

In the late fall, this non-juried event is open to all members as an opportunity to display and sell work in a classy gallery setting for three days.

### Art in Public Places

Participating artists display work on rotation in about six public or business locations around town. Work is for sale and is so very appreciated by viewers within our community.

### Member Meetings

Held on the 2nd Monday of each month (excluding June, July and August) in the Wimberley Community Center, these meetings update members about coming events and generally feature a presentation or demonstration by an artist. Join us at 6:00 for mingling, 6:30 for the business meeting and 7:00 for the presentation.

### Holiday Party

Gather with other members for a potluck dinner in lieu of a December member meeting, come enjoy good food and company and a lively discussion of Wimberley arts.
